

FORTHCOMING COMPETITIONS FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER-NOVEMBER

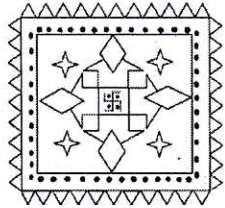

To imbibe the creativity in our Dipsites, Class- II is organising an Intra Section **"Paper Rangoli Making Competition"** on **October 18, 2016 i.e. Tuesday.**

Kindly Note: The child is required to practice the pattern of rangoli (either the printed pattern or the child can draw the pattern) on A-4 size sheet at home.



- ☺ On the final day of the competition please send the Rangoli design printed/drawn on A-4 size sheet. The child is required to do all the decoration work in the class.
- ☺ Decorative material like glitters powder, wood powder, buttons, bindis, coloured rice etc. can be brought.
- ☺ Scissors, fevicol (if required), black sketch pen for outling should be brought from home.
- ☺ Please send a rough cloth and an old newspaper to organise the craft material on the table.

Kindly Note: The child is required to:

- Present himself/herself as any endangered or extinct animal like dinosaur, tiger, dodo etc. and he/she should express his/her feelings- Where do they live? Which family they belong to? What do they like to eat? How do they feel about humans? What are the causes due to which they are extinct animals? etc (Example: I am a Tiger, I belong to the cat family
- Enact the character and speak at least 10-12 lines. **(Only in English)**
- Come dressed up as any species. A prop may be carried along to enhance the presentation.

Judgement Criteria: Creativity, Content, Costume/Props, Presentation.
