We are pleased to inform you that QRG Health City has invited our school students to join the **World Hand Hygiene Day Poster Competition And Slogan Writing Competition**. This day is declared by the World Health Organization (WHO) from 2005 onwards to create awareness about the virtues of good hand hygiene practices.

The Themes of the competition are as below-

Poster competition-"Make Handwashing a Habit!"(Grade 1-Grade 4)

Poster competition-"SAVE LIVES: Clean Your Hands!"(Grade 5-Grade 9)

Slogan competition- in Hindi and English.

POSTER MAKING COMPETITION INSTRUCTIONS

Drawing / Painting Rules

- Drawing / painting must be on paper of A3 size (297 x 420 mm) or A2 size (420 x 594 mm).
- Acceptable tools of drawing / painting include pencil, crayon, water colour, oil paint, etc. Photographs, wires, computer drawing, and other 3D objects are not acceptable. The completed artwork must be on a flat piece of paper.
- The drawing / painting must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any religious theme.
- Name, Class, School, Address, Phone and Email must be clearly mentioned on the back of poster in the English Language.
- The theme should be the main focus of the poster.
- No text (including theme title, name, etc.) should be written on the front of the poster.
- **The poster must be made at home and sent to the Class Teacher by May 3,2017 as the same will be collected by QRG staff from the school on May 3,2017**
- A poster should be an individual effort of a child.
- All posters will be displayed in the reception lobby of QRG on 6th May
- Winning posters in each category will be awarded.
- The parents can accompany their children on 6th May at QRG ,Health City to view the display and attend the programme and award ceremony (10 am to 6 am).
- Once the winning poster has been chosen it will be turned into an actual poster to be used around the hospital

SLOGAN COMPETITION

- Separate slogans are required to be submitted for each of the topics.
- A phrase should inspire many to follow the theme / A phrase that will express a strong sense of purpose of the theme and should be original.
- A slogan should have minimum four lines
- Every entry should contain the following details: Name, Class, School, Address, Phone and Email.
- Maximum of 2 entries allowed per student per topic.
- Entries submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
- **Entries should be in English or Hindi should be submitted directly by E-mail to handhygiene.qrg@gmail.com by 4th May.**
- 10 selected entries will get to recite the slogan at the programme.
