**Our Little ones are at the end of first semester. It is best time to recapitulate all the concepts done till now. Here are some suggested activities and games for our little learners to enhance their skills.**

1- Hopscotch- Hopscotch is a traditional game that still brings loads of fun and laughter in children's learning, with easy steps you can create your own hopscotch at home with numbers and letters.



2- Sight Word Wall - Make a Sight Word Wall/ flashcards to enhance reading skills.



3- Make a sand pit box- Take an old shoe box/any other box. Fill it with sand and let your child explore the world of letters and numbers.



4- Fun with playdough- Let the child make balls using play dough and count as per the number given or make the outline of different shapes.



5- Picture Flashcard Fun- To enhance the vocabulary and imagination of the child. Prepare 4-5 picture flashcards related to each letter. Let him/her identify the picture and the beginning sound.
