Dear Parent

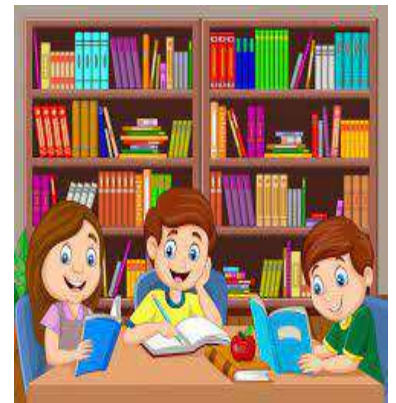
